Facebook Live—101

Question: What is a Facebook Live? How do I see it?

Answer: A Facebook Live is a quick way to take a video of yourself or something/someone else and share it with an audience on Facebook. It's quick to set up, easy to use and view, and you have the ability to control the size of the audience you want to be able to see the video. It's probably the easiest way to "Live Stream" something. To view a Facebook Live post from Central: Log into Facebook. Click on the icon that looks like a ("Search"). magnifying glass Type "Central Christian in Church, Decatur, IL." This will give you options of pages to click on, but ours should be near the top. Click on our listing, and it will take you to our Facebook page. When the service begins recording (which will be VERY close to start time), you'll see a post pop up that says "Central Christian Church is live now," and you'll see the video playing. Click on it, and enjoy your worship experience!

New Normal – Easter Opportunities

Even though we are living in a new reality – that of being socially distanced from one another, we are still seeking ways for things to be as normal as possible. As we near the season of Easter, there are two opportunities for you to experience a little bit of normalcy in the midst of all this newness.

First, Easter lilies will still be sold. From April 1 – 9, you may place an order by calling the church Tuesday through Thursday between 8:00 am - noon, or e-mailing anytime (central@cccdisciples.org). You will need to notify us: 1) how many you would like; 2) the name of the loved one you are remembering or honoring. The cost will be \$15.00 per flower. Checks should be made out to "Central Christian Church" and mailed to the church with "Easter Lilies" on the memo line. If we are still worshiping online only, the lilies may be picked up on Easter Sunday, April 12th, from noon until 2:00 p.m. We will have drive through pick up at the West entrance. Please note that we only have 40 Easter Lilies this year, and when they are purchased, no more orders will be taken.

Additionally, one of the great traditions of Easter is the homecoming that takes place as we are able to visit with friends we may not have seen recently. While we certainly cannot replicate that sense of fellowship, we are proud to offer a special Easter event. On **Saturday April 11th**, we will be offering a *Hearty Vegetable Soup* meal to all of our church family and the homes in our surrounding neighborhood. Here are the particulars: Between **10:00 a.m. and noon** on April 11th, we will deliver soup to all who wish to participate. We will place the soup at your **front door**. If you are able and comfortable with being out and about, you can pick up your soup at the **ramp entrance** to the church. No need to get out. It will be brought to your car. Hopefully while you enjoy your soup, you can prayerfully reflect on the wonderful worship services we have enjoyed together in the past and look forward to the day that we can worship together again and thank God for his many blessings. Salt Dough Easter Eggs - Supply List

- batch or two of salt dough (see below)

- rolling pin

- ruler, to measure dough thickness

egg shape cutter

spatula

- straw, for making holes

- parchment-paper covered baking sheets

- spray or acrylic paint

paint pens, optional

- clear coat sealer, optional

- twine, ribbon

Recipe for Salt Dough Easter Eggs

Mix up your favorite salt dough recipe. For this project, I used the following recipe:

1 cup flour 1/2 cup salt 1/2 cup water

Stir together all three ingredients until a dough forms. Kneading the dough a couple times can help make it smoother.

Roll it out (I rolled mine to 1/4 inch thick) and cut out desired shapes.

Place the salt dough Easter eggs on the parchment-covered baking sheets. Remember to make a hole so you can hang the ornaments — a straw works perfectly!

Bake at 250F for 2 hours.

Once the shapes are adequately baked, dried and then thoroughly cooled, it's painting time. I like using spray paint because it's faster and easier but acrylics work just as well. Allow the paint to thoroughly dry. Use paint pens to add polka dots or lines of decorations to the eggs.

Optional: To further protect the color and design, add a clear coat sealer. Loop the twine or ribbon through the holes and hang.
