COVID-19 and Nursing Homes

Members of Central’s Peace and Justice Task Force have been meeting regularly by zoom with the Decatur chapter of Illinois People’s Action during the pandemic. The primary topic has been the spread (or potential spread) of COVID-19 in local nursing homes. The IPA is advocating that nursing homes follow state guidelines and that they be transparent with the public about what is happening in their respective facilities. For example: What are the criteria for moving a patient with COVID-19 from a nursing home to a hospital? What kind of medical and supportive care can a person expect a loved one to receive if they are diagnosed with COVID-19, exposed to it and/or worried about contracting it? Text Giving Now Available

Giving by text is the newest way to make contributions to Central. If you are already familiar with on-line giving through Central’s website, you will find the process is similar:

- Text “GIVE” to (217) 212-2173. You will receive a secure link to www.ShelbyGiving.com, which directs your contribution to Central.
- Choose “Give Now” and follow the prompts to select the fund, donation amount, and your payment information, then tap ‘submit.’

The system will automatically save your personal information and payment source, so you do not need to re-enter it when you make subsequent gifts. Text and on-line giving offer new ways that Central members and friends can contribute to the church’s many ministries. Many people prefer to donate by writing a check or, for those who use online banking, by setting up direct payments from their bank. Like online giving, direct payments from your bank can be one-time or recurring donations.

"Heroes!" Sermon Series

Humble? Selfless? Courageous? Inspiring? How would you define a hero? Would you use one of these characteristics? Which of them seems most "heroic" to you? **Heroes!** will be the focus of our new six-week sermon series at Central Christian. In the process of taking a closer look at some (possibly) lesser-known heroes in scripture, we will discover three (3) important truths about heroes.

- First, heroes don't have to look a particular way. They certainly don't need to appear other-worldly. In fact, heroes probably look more like you and I than we tend to think.
- Second, heroes don't set out to be heroes. On the contrary, heroes *become* heroes in the course of living the life before them.
- Finally, heroes inspire us to be better! They are enough like us so that we see ourselves in them, but they are enough un-like us to motivate us to become something more than we are today.
