### Sermon Outline "Heroes are... Honest!"

Saul – first king of united kingdom (Israel) Saul displeases God (in battle and in worship) A new "heir" to the throne desired

David – easily overlooked but anointed future king Slew the giant Goliath of the enemy Philistines (popularity grows) Problem: Saul not dead (sees David as threat) David on the run

### David as King

Impregnates another man's wife (Bathsheba) Dilemma: child must appear to be husband's (Uriah) Problem: Uriah on the battlefield (not at home) Solution???:

> Bring Uriah home to spend time with his wife Two times Uriah fails to do so David has Uriah killed in battle

God displeased

Sends prophet Nathan to call David to account David genuinely remorseful and is spared

Uriah – with his actions Nathan – with his words David??? – with himself

### 2 Samuel 12:5-9, 13-14 (NRSV)

<sup>5</sup> Then David's anger was greatly kindled against the man. He said to Nathan, "As the LORD lives, the man who has done this deserves to die; <sup>6</sup> he shall restore the lamb fourfold, because he did this thing, and because he had no pity." <sup>7</sup> Nathan said to David, "You are the man! Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel: I anointed you king over Israel, and I rescued you from the hand of Saul; <sup>8</sup> I gave

you your master's house, and your master's wives into your bosom, and gave you the house of Israel and of Judah; and if that had been too little, I would have added as much more. <sup>9</sup> Why have you despised the word of the LORD, to do what is evil in his sight? You have struck down Uriah the Hittite with the sword, and have taken his wife to be your wife, and have killed him with the sword of the Ammonites.
