A Word About Worship Schedules

From having read *The Visitor* over the years, you have undoubtedly noticed that we print a schedule of worship assignments for the coming week's worship service. Given that we are gradually introducing in-person worship again, in the midst of the ongoing pandemic, we wanted to share some important information with you.

- First, all existing schedules (deacons, greeters, liturgists and ushers) have been <u>temporarily suspended</u>.
- Second, a new schedule has been made with some new volunteer titles (e.g. "Front Door Check-in"). This is the schedule that will be printed in *The Visitor* each week. For the foreseeable future, a smaller group of volunteers will be handling these new volunteer roles. Since not everyone on the original schedules published in early 2020 feels comfortable coming back to in-person worship, this was thought to be the most efficient way to proceed for the time being.
- Third, should we return to more "normal" Sunday morning practices, we may very well re-institute the schedules first published in early 2020.
- Fourth, should you be interested in helping out with these new in-person worship volunteer opportunities (and are not yet on the schedule), please let us know and we can add you to the roster of volunteers (central@cccdisciples.org).

<u>Letting Go</u>

A week ago Monday, our Central Christian Preschool board made a very difficult decision – not to open the preschool for in-person learning this fall. This was due to two (2) primary reasons. First was the (obvious) uncertainty of the COVID-19 pandemic, and the second was the fact that our former preschool director resigned in early April, and the board was simply unable to identify a DCFS-qualified candidate who could maintain the high standards long a staple of the preschool and its 50-plus year reputation. I wanted to share a portion of the letter that was sent out to parents last week, as well as thank the preschool board members for their tireless efforts and hard work over the last few months. They are: Becky Flanders (president), Donna Dash (treasurer), Gretchen Kirby (secretary), Mike Munos, Carrie Funk, Debbie Hoffert, Tonya Morelli, and Jeff Romine. The last two are preschool parents, and Tonya is also a church member.

Dear parents, this is not a letter that anyone associated with the Central Christian Preschool or the church itself would ever want to write. As you know, our director resigned her position this past April. While the board has given great effort to find a replacement over these past few months, and pursued every option available to us, the results have been unsuccessful. Due to the uncertainty of the COVID pandemic and this key staff vacancy, we regretfully announce that we are <u>delaying the opening of the Central Christian Preschool until Fall 2021</u>.

We have every intention of keeping our DCFS license and will continue our search for a qualified director, aiming for a Fall 2021 return of in-person learning. Again, we are deeply saddened to make this decision, and thank you for your past and present interest and support in our preschool. We furthermore know that your children are the most precious part of your lives, and we do trust that you will find educational opportunities for them worthy of all they deserve to receive.
