<u>Sermon Outline</u> "Un-Changed: One Faith"

Early church – everyone was a "convert" Jews Gentiles / Greeks – former non-Jews

How to be a Christian? Faith for sure But what about Jewish Law (eating habits, circumcision)

Galatia

Paul plants church with no mention of need for the Law After he leaves, others come and say the Law is needed *Church in danger of splitting* Letter to the Galatians is Paul's answer

- v. 23 before Christ, Law was helpful
- v. 24 was our "guide" ("pedagogue") that served a purpose for a time
- v. 25 with Christ, Law not needed as before
- v. 26 through faith we are one family (No second-class citizens) (Baptism takes place of circumcision)
- v. 27 28
 - ethnicity, social class, economic status, gender none matter

How we practice faith is less important than THAT we have faith

Pandemic has forced us to change (old habits die hard)

- What has remained Un-Changed
 - Our ONE faith
 - The unifying and uniting character of that faith

Galatians 3:23-29 (NRSV)

²³ Now before faith came, we were imprisoned and guarded under the law until faith would be revealed. ²⁴ Therefore the law was our disciplinarian until Christ came, so that we might be justified by faith. ²⁵ But now that faith has come, we are no longer subject to a disciplinarian, ²⁶ for in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith. ²⁷ As many of you as were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. ²⁸ There is no longer Jew or Greek, there is no longer slave or free, there is no longer male and female; for all of you are one in Christ Jesus. ²⁹ And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's offspring,^[a] heirs according to the promise.

Questions for Reflection

Who was a someone that helped you grow on your faith journey? Who was a "spiritual guide" (or "spiritual pedagogue") that helped you become the person of faith you are today?

Of all the Christian practices (worship, prayer, baptism, communion, giving offerings, acts of service...), which is the one that comes easiest to you? Which is more difficult?

When was a time you experienced the kind of "Unity in Christ" that Paul describes in vv. 27-28?
