A New Heart for a New Year



Now that we have "laid 2020 to rest," faithfully and respectfully, we are ready to turn the page on the new year! Our first sermon series for 2021 is titled: "A New Heart for a New Year" and is based on a Celtic prayer called "Lord of My Heart." The prayer contains 5 specific petitions and each sermon of the series is based on one of those petitions. This series is the product of a collaborative effort among 5 Disciples of Christ pastors from around the country — David Emery (Tulsa, OK), Ike Nicholson (Littleton, CO), Michael Schwartzentruber (Lexington, KY), David Charlton (Shelbyville, KY) and myself. Here is a schedule of what to expect on Sunday mornings:

January 10	Lord of my Heart Give me Vision	Ezekiel 36:26, Eph 1:17-20
January 17	Lord of my Heart Give me Light	John 8:12-15
January 24	Lord of my Heart Give me Wisdom	I Corinthians 18-29
January 31	Lord of my Heart Give me Courage	Joshua 1:5-9
February 7	Lord of my Heart Give me <u>Trust</u>	Jeremiah 17:5-8

We also put together a "virtual small group study guide" to go along with this series that includes Zoom interviews with 5 prominent people (mostly Disciples of Christ leaders) from around the country. Moreover, each week will include a spiritual challenge to accomplish sometime during the week that follows each sermon. More information will come next week about the virtual study guide and the spiritual challenges – and the Celtic prayer on which this series is based will be shared as well.
