

Challenges and Opportunities

Each week of this new sermon series - "A New Heart for a New Year" – we will be issuing a challenge to undertake during the week that follows. This will be based on the sermon theme for the day (which, in turn, is based on one of the petitions from the Celtic prayer "Lord of My Heart"). The intention is that this prayer take root in our hearts and lead to our spiritual growth. We hope the challenges help in that regard. This week, there are actually two.

The first challenge is to create a <u>Vision Board</u> for the sermon series. I'm including pictures both of Pastor Tina's and my own. Your board can look more like hers, or mine, or completely *un*-like either of them. At the very least, it should include some piece of paper divided into 5 sections (one for each week of the series), with some amount of room to put things into each section.



The second challenge is related to this past Sunday's sermon theme of "Vision." In the section of your Vision Board marked "vision," we want you to spend time reflecting on the following four (4) questions. Once you have done so, you can write your answers in the "vision" section on your board (or you may choose to put anything else in that section of your board that relates to these questions). Here are the questions for reflection:

- 1) What kind of person do I want to become in 2021?
- 2) What brings me joy and fulfillment? (not because of the outcome, but simply in the doing of it?)
- 3) How is this pleasing to God? In what way is God honored by this?
- 4) How are others made better by this?

Finally, an opportunity this week! Beginning <u>Sunday</u>, <u>January 17</u>, we will be offering <u>in-person worship</u> again at all three (3) of our services.

Here's what you will need to know:

- If you are not yet comfortable coming back to in-person worship,
 - don't worry. We will continue to live-stream all 3 services
 - (traditional worship on the website and Facebook,
 - contemporary on Facebook)
- If you are planning on coming back to in-person worship:
 - You will allowed in to the building 10 minutes before the beginning of worship. So please don't show up sooner than this
 - Enter through the West Entrance. We will have our regular
 check-in procedures (temperature check, handwashing, sign in, masks)
 - For traditional worship, the first 25 people will be seated on the main level of the sanctuary. Everyone after that will be seated in the balcony.
 - For traditional worship we will also be printing a bulletin. You will be able to pick these up with your communion supplies. We will not, however, be using hymnals or pew bibles.
