Ash Wednesday, February 17

We will impose "drive thru" ashes and offer a Lenten prayer for you and your household as you drive through. If we are

not outside exactly at 12:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. go ahead and form a line of cars. We will be there as soon as we can and will be present for **30 minutes** (so... from 12:30 - 1:00 p.m. and then from 5:30 - 6:00 p.m.). - Michael

<u>S.W.O.T.</u>

In this column space two weeks ago, I shared a partial re-cap from our first Visioning Team meeting on January 23. In it, I invited you – on behalf of the team – to reflect on the six-word mission statement: *Share Christ. Change Lives. Deliver Hope.* For those that responded to me or to Gregg Foltz, our Vision Team leader, thank you. Your responses have been noted. For those that have not, but would like to, there is still time; simply send them along with anything you might want to share upon reading this article.

One of the exercises the Vision Team undertook was called <u>S.W.O.T. Analysis</u>. This is an activity long used in the world of strategic planning that asks an organization to analyze itself through the lens of Strengths (S), Weaknesses (W), Opportunities (O), and Threats (T). Our facilitator Bruce Nims explained each of the areas of analysis as follows:

Strengths – This has to do with what's happening <u>inside</u> our congregation. Specifically...

- What do we really well at Central? What are we good at?
- What are our "super-powers?" What would people say we are known for?
- What capabilities do we have that could be used to succeed in the future?

Weaknesses – These also have to do with what's happening <u>internally</u>. Specifically...

- What are we not so good at? Where do we struggle?
- What deficiencies do we have that could cause us problems and limit our success?

Opportunities – This has to do with what's happening <u>outside</u> our congregation. Specifically...

- What's going on *in the world outside Central* (our neighborhood, our city, and beyond) that is <u>promising</u> for us?
 - What trends can we take advantage of?
 - What needs can we fill?

Threats – This also has to do with what's happening externally. Specifically...

- What's going on in the world outside Central, that bodes <u>poorly</u> for us in the years to come?
- What trends will challenge our success?

Again, we want you (the wider church) to feel part of this process as we undertake it. To that end, if you have things you'd like to share as you read through these questions, we'd love to hear them and add them to the ones we've already identified. "Telling Mark's Good News!" – Small Group Opportunity

As you know, I do a lot of memorizing scripture. What you probably don't know is what a deeply spiritual experience it is for me and how much it helps me grow in my own connection to scripture. I want to share the gift of memorizing and reciting scripture with you!!! Every week during Lent (February 17 – March 28), I will meet with all those interested for one hour. We will spend 6 weeks memorizing sections of the **Passion Story** of Jesus as told in the Gospel of Mark (Mark chapters 14:1 - 16:8). At the end of the class, students will perform a memorized section of the story. It will be filmed and the video will be shown the week before Easter. This has the potential to be an amazing gift - both to you, if you choose to participate, and to the whole church which will be able to see the videos during Holy Week. We will spend the 6 weeks of the small group picking our sections of the story to tell; memorizing; workshopping; discussing ways of acting out the words we memorize; and more!!! Each person will be responsible for as few as 10-12 verses (but can do more if they choose). I will work with however many are interested - from 2 to 12 or more. This class is designed to be in-person and we will meet in the Friendship Center where we can spread out (masks required as well except when workshopping your memorized piece).
