We will also be imposing ashes for those who wish to receive them. Pastors Don and Tina and myself will come to those where they are sitting and impose them on forehead or back of hand. We'll wear masks and use a q-tip to impose the ashes. For those who are uncomfortable with in-person worship, we are inviting you to drive by the church at 12:30 p.m. or 5:30 p.m. and drive through the West Entrance. We will impose "drive thru" ashes and offer a Lenten prayer for you and

your household as you drive through. If we are not outside exactly at 12:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. go ahead and form a line of cars. We will be there as soon as we can and will be present for **30 minutes** (so... from 12:30 – 1:00 p.m. and then from 5:30 - 6:00 p.m.). - Michael

This week, we begin the season of Lent which is the season in the church year encompassing the 7 weeks prior to Easter. The word "Lent" comes from a word that means "lengthening of days" which happens in the Springtime, but spiritually speaking, Lent is a time of refocusing our lives on Christ and striving to follow him more intentionally. As you know, we are undergoing a time of visioning this winter and spring – as we think about our mission as a congregation. We would like our worship during Lent to accompany the work the vision leadership team is undertaking.

To that end, our theme in worship will be "Mission." Each Sunday, our worship will be built on the six (6) important words that we have named as our "mission" at Central Christian - Share. Christ. It's there at the end of the Ws for a reason. The period represents "that is all." ## <u>"Telling Mark's Good News!" –</u> Small Group Opportunity

As you know, I do a lot of memorizing scripture. What you probably don't know is what a deeply spiritual experience it is for me and how much it helps me grow in my own connection to scripture. I want to share the gift of

memorizing and reciting scripture with you!!! Every week during Lent (February 17 – March 28), I will meet with all those interested for one hour. We will spend 6 weeks memorizing sections of the **Passion Story** of Jesus as told in the Gospel of Mark (Mark chapters 14:1 - 16:8). At the end of the class, students will perform a memorized section of the story. It will be filmed and the video will be shown the week before Easter. This has the potential to be an amazing gift – both to you, if you choose to participate, and to the whole church, which will be able to see the videos during Holy Week. We will spend the 6 weeks of the small group picking our sections of the story to tell; memorizing; workshopping; discussing ways of acting out the words we memorize; and more!!! Each person will be responsible for as few as 10-12 verses (but can do more if they choose). I will work with however many are interested – from 2 to 12 or more. This class is designed to be in-person and we will meet in the Friendship Center where we can spread out (masks required as well – except when workshopping your memorized piece).
