

# Minister's Article

# Something Good to think and Pray about this Week

The devotional book I am using for 2021, in addition to daily scripture readings and questions for reflections, has a longer devotion for each week. It is printed under the title, "Something good to think and pray about this week." It is usually an excerpt from another publication having something to do with spiritual health. The submission for this week was from Gavin Thomas Murphy and his book, *Bursting Out in Praise: Spirituality and Mental Health*. As I read it, I thought it an appropriate reflection to consider during the Lenten season. I share it with you here:



Too many of us learn to "love" distress and anxiety. That is, we <u>say</u> it is just the way of work and the world and that we have to accept it. Just five minutes of silence seems pointless, we think. But the reality is that we get in touch with the "inner teacher" when we find times to be still in our day, connecting us with deep peace and balance. (Be still and know that I am God... Psalm 46:10). That stillness is available to be tapped into as we live in the moment: listening to others, being present to the tasks required of us, walking with a fresh breeze on our faces... The simple things, which become important the more we are aware of them.

In scripture we see how the Good Shepherd invites us to this kind of stillness. He calls us to rest awhile among the grassy meadows and flowing streams. He wants us to relax in his presence – to be nourished, strengthened and renewed. In his presence, we may turn from a closed fist of denial, frustration and turmoil to an open hand of acceptance, relaxation and serenity. And after the rest, we are invited to walk more closely with him; to be freer and more confident, and to be better able to navigate the often-hazy paths of life. It is true that we all need to work on maintaining balance in our lives, but we are not alone. And the good news is that there is room for all us in the presence of the Good Shepherd.


