

The Vision Team continues to meet to develop CCC's strategic plan for the next three to five years. A key to success is not only gaining input from the Vision Team, but from <u>everyone</u> in the congregation. Michael's current sermon series WWW. parallels the vision team's work. We have already received input from congregants based on feedback requested in The Visitor and Michael's sermons. **Please continue your good work, as everyone's input is important.**

Vision Team Roundtables

The Vision Team would like to share with you an update on where we stand on the visioning process as well as getting your feedback as it continues its work. It is important that our strategic plan for fulfilling our mission over the next 4-5 years is one that we all have a voice in formulating and one that we are all excited about supporting.

To that end Gregg Foltz, Vision Team leader, is inviting you to attend one of two (2) roundtable discussions. The format for these discussions will be as follows:

- Gregg and some other members of the Vision Team will share what it believes Central's <u>Core Values</u> are (that is, what the non-negotiable characteristics are that best describe our congregation); and what the <u>Focus Areas of Ministry</u> we should embrace over the next 4-5 years.

The Vision Team representatives will be interested in hearing from you whether or not the team is on the "right track." That is... Is the Vision Team's impression of the church on the same page as your own? And when you think of where we should focus our energies and resources going forward, is that similar to what the Vision Team is thinking?

- Additionally, the Vision Team would like to hear from you regarding what you think our "next steps" might be.
 - Once we have the Focus Areas of Ministry identified, we will want to name a handful for specific projects for each area that our church should undertake.
 - The Vision Team would be interested in hearing what kinds of projects interest you and behind which you would be willing to stand.

Maundy Thursday

Make your plans to attend worship on **Maundy Thursday (Thursday, April 1) at 7:00 p.m.** You may attend in person or online. The service will be the dramatic re-telling of the Passion Story of Jesus as told by the Gospel of Mark. The word passion means "suffer", and the Passion Story tells of the suffering and death of Jesus which precedes Easter. Communion will be taken as part of the dramatic re-telling.



As our Maundy Thursday Passion Story is told, the sanctuary will become ever darker until the service ends with the burial of Jesus. When we re-convene on Easter Sunday, we will begin worship with a dramatic recitation of the resurrection of Jesus (Mark 16:1-8).
