

Many have taken us up on this challenge and have shared their testimonies with us. As they do, we are asking them to share them in worship. We will then publish the testimony in *The Visitor* the following week. Tom Spry, regular attender of the 10:30 service, elder, and long-time member, offered his faith in 60 seconds this past Sunday. Here is what he said:



I believe the root cause of my Christianity is the teachings of my parents and the resulting beliefs and way of life instilled in me as a child. I am the fifth of six children born into a southwest Missouri family. My Dad was a carpenter and often worked evenings and weekends to help provide for his family. During my childhood, Mom and Dad did not go to church regularly, but they insisted that I and my siblings must go to learn about the bible and Jesus. Together they taught us about faith, sharing, hard work, honesty, commitment, and helping others. They often talked about Grandma and Grandpa being in heaven and

shared with us the hope they had of someday joining them there. They made sure we knew why we celebrate Easter and Christmas and why we too have the hope of eternal salvation.

During my lifetime, there have been times that I too did not attend church on a regular basis. Thankfully there were many people along my life's journey who helped me find my way back to Christ but it was those early childhood teachings that made me want to come back. On this Mother's Day, I thank God for my Mom, and for my Dad, and for the love and guidance they gave me and my siblings throughout their lives. I give thanks for the seed they placed in me as a child that developed into a Christian foundation, upon which, I have built my life. Thanks be to God.
