Update on COVID Procedures

Beginning Sunday, June 13 we will no longer require the wearing of face coverings as we have since July of 2020. We do ask that you bring one with you every time you come to Central and that you are prepared to put one on when working with, or in the presence of, children. Our nursery staff and those leading children's messages and working directly with children will continue to wear masks

when doing so. Additionally, we want those who feel more comfortable wearing masks at worship and church events to feel welcome to continue doing so. We will continue to have a handwashing and sign-in station at the entrances, but we will no longer ask everyone to follow the guidelines as it regards to wearing masks that we instituted on July 5, 2020.



KNIGHTS OF NORTH CASTLE VBS 2021

Central Christian Church VBS will occur this Friday and Saturday! We will see a special VBS presentation Sunday, June 13th at the 10:30 service. Here is a pre-view of what kiddos will experience!

Cokesbury's VBS, Knights of North Castle: Quest for the King's Armor, invites children to be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his power by exploring how we put on the armor of God. Kids will take on the role of brave Knights and begin their quest each session by opening the King's Book.

They will explore Old and New Testament stories and discover different pieces of protective armor — **the Belt of Truth, the Breastplate of Justice, the Shield of Faith, and the Helmet of Salvation** — at work in the lives of familiar Bible characters and explore how that armor works in their own lives as they follow and serve God.

VBS will begin in the main sanctuary where Sparky the Dragon and the Armorer lead Castle Callouts: Armor up with Truth, Armor up with Justice, Armor up with Faith, and Armor up with Salvation! The group will move to the Great Hall for lessons, crafts, and snacks.

Each session is packed with music, bible adventure videos, crafts, prayers, bible stories, and activities. All the fun will make for hungry children. Our leaders are prepared with super-yummy, pre-packaged snacks and drinks.

Crafts are a favorite part of VBS. Our Knights of the North Castle are sure to create happy memories and lasting artwork during out time together. They will make a belt of truth; a reminder to stay strong and always tell the truth. A plaque of justice is useful reminder to stand up for what is right and just. The shield of faith illustrates how faith in God can give us strength to do amazing things. All knights and knight leaders will go home with a helmet of salvation. We are all part of God's family on a quest to **be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his power.**

Your Faith in 60 Seconds




