How have you responded when you found yourself in moments of transition or in uncertain and unfamiliar territory?

Threshold Moments

Threshold moment: a moment in time between that which was and that which was to come.

Liminal space: a space of in-between. Liminal spaces are sacred (if we allow them to be). They are points of contact between our reality and God's reality—spaces for profound impact—these are what I call threshold moments.

Ruth based her faith on the larger story of God's steadfast love and trusted him to help her through the transition.

Psalm 121.8 relates:

The LORD will watch over your coming and going,
both now and forevermore.

Maybe you are in a liminal space, a threshold moment.

Words of encouragement from the promises found in Scripture:

God promised to save us:

1 John 2:25

This is the promise which He Himself ^[a]made to us: eternal life.

God promised to bless our efforts:

Psalm 126:6

He who goes to and fro weeping, carrying *his* bag of seed,
Shall indeed come again with a shout of joy, bringing his sheaves *with him*.

God promised to forgive our sins:

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

God promised to answer our prayers:

Matthew 7:7

"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you."

God promised to meet our needs:

Luke 12:31

"But seek His kingdom, and these things will be added to you."

God promised to claim us in heaven:

John 14:3

"If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, *there* you may be also."
