## Faith in 60 Seconds

Last Spring, we introduced a challenge to everyone: Describe why you are a Christian in 60 seconds. Why we believe in Christ and not something (someone) else? As people have taken up that challenge and shared their testimonies in worship, we have then published their words in *The Visitor* the following week. One of our elders, Linda Virgil, offered her faith in 60 seconds this past Sunday. Here is what she said:

Why am I a Christian? The fact that I was born into it is a major contributing factor. But then, the question becomes ---why do I continue to embrace Christianity? I continue because Christianity shows me that love is the ultimate reality. It further promises that one day I will live with God in perfect love. It is Christianity that proclaims that "God is Love" or "Love is God" — whichever way you want to say it! I know of no other faith that has love at its core in the same way Christianity does. Christianity has offered to me the perfect example of what love looks like in the life and actions of Jesus.

When life throws me a curve and becomes almost too painful to bear, as it certainly has for me, or when I'm challenged to be the loving person God wants me to be, I can turn to Jesus. I can look at his life and listen to his teachings. He tells me that, if I am to live in love, I am to be patient, I am to be kind, I must not insist on my own way, I am to believe, I am to trust ---all the attributes of love Paul describes in I Corinthians 13. It is Christianity that tells me that love for God and love for my fellow man is what I must strive for if I am to know God, have a
