- Read Deuteronomy 15:7-11
 - What are the characteristics of a "good neighbor" shown in Deuteronomy 15:7-11? (Make a list as a small group.)
 - What are the ways our church could exemplify those characteristics in our immediate neighborhood today? With Millikin students?

Prayer

Close with a prayer that thanks God for the good neighbors you've known and which asks for the grace to be "good neighbors" as your small group has discussed.


A life-long Disciples of Christ, I grew up in Decatur and was a member of Crestview Christian Church. For many years, my husband Scott and I made our home in Eureka, IL, during which time we attended Eureka Christian Church. Upon moving back to Decatur in 2012, we have made Central our church home. My career has been as a teacher of young children. I recently retired from working at Head Start as an educational coach. My love and passion have always been for children and their families.

Over the past 3 years, I have been a student in our Regional Church's School for Ministry, which is a program for lay persons to study and discern their call for commissioned ministry. As a part of my work in this program, I am serving as an intern here at Central. I will be participating in worship regularly over the next three months, as well as preaching one Sunday this fall. As my passion is for children and their families, I'm especially interested in offering support to parents and grandparents as they share faith with their children.

Looking back, what do you remember from when you were first learning about God and Jesus? Was it from singing "Jesus Love Me" or bedtime and mealtime prayers? Did you attend worship, VBS, church camp? Who were the people who shared their love of God and faith with you? Perhaps it's none of these things but something else significant in your life.



The rest is history. There is no doubt in my mind that the Lord sent Karen into my life that day. I had so many more things to do. I believe every day I wake up that my faith will carry me through anything that comes my way. I always end my prayers with this line, "Lord, wrap your arms around me and hold me close, til I bow at your feet."
