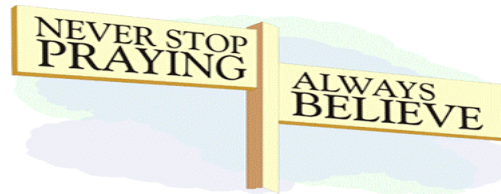

Starter Question

What was the first prayer you remember learning? Was it a bedtime prayer? A meal prayer? Another prayer?

Sermon: The Lord's Prayer

Matthew 6:5-13

The first statements are about God

Abba – informal / relationship / connection / belonging
Heaven and Holy – God is in control
Will done on earth... – Our purpose: to be a reflection of God here!

The second statements are about us

Daily bread – what I need to survive today
Forgive us – we always “owe” more
Lead us not / deliver us – anything can be a threat and temptation to our faithfulness

Prayer Practice for the Week:

For each of five (5) days this week, focus on a different part of the Lord's Prayer

- Day 1 - Holiness – praise God for the sacredness of creation*
- Day 2 - Kingdom on earth – pick one way you will be more Christ-like in the way you live your daily life this week*
- Day 3 - Bread – pray to be satisfied with what you have.
See the richness in what you have already*
- Day 4 - Temptation – Share with God something that tempts you in your daily life and ask God to relieve the pressure it puts on you*
- Day 5 - Deliverance from evil – Share with God something you want to be freed from in your life and ask God to help deliver you from it*

Matthew 6:5-13 NRSV

⁵“And whenever you pray, do not be like the hypocrites; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and at the street corners, so that they may be seen by others. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward. ⁶But whenever you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you. ⁷“When you are praying, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do; for they think that they will be heard because of their many words. ⁸Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

hallowed be your name.

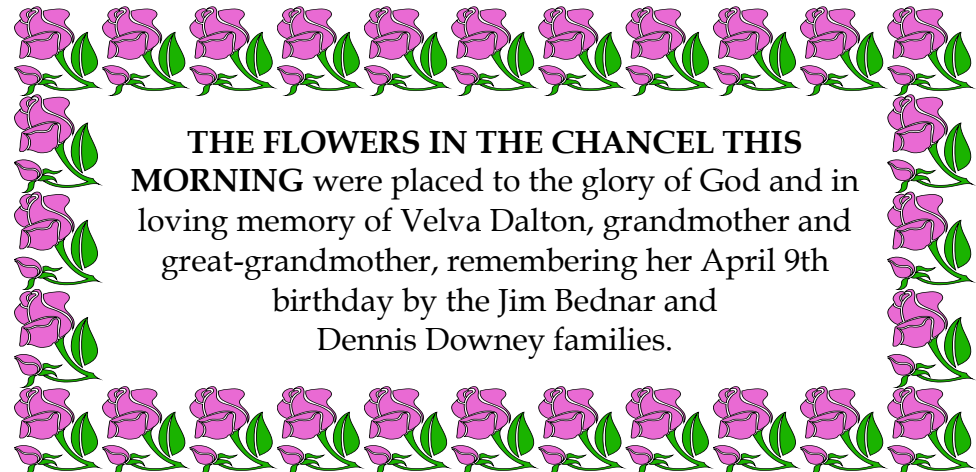
¹⁰ Your kingdom come.
