Obtain your Advent Candles (and Wreath) Now...

Advent 2020 begins on Sunday, November 29 (the Sunday of Thanksgiving weekend). This is the season that encompasses the 4 Sundays prior to Christmas and helps us prepare spiritually for Christ's coming. For Advent at Central Christian 2020, we are asking you to pay attention to the following:

1. Order NOW your own advent wreath with candles OR just the advent candles. See Page 3 for a few links to show you some options. There should be 4 candles (3 purple and 1 pink). You may or may not include a wreath with those candles, and you may prefer votives to tapers, but either way, make your plans to purchase your own. During this pandemic of 2020, we have some creative ways of uniting our congregation around the advent candles (both the in-person and the on-line) with some activities that you can do at home with your household as you prepare for Christmas.
2. We plan on supplying you (the church family household) with a litany that you can recite and pray each weekend of Advent! This will be the SAME litany that we will be speaking during worship that Sunday morning! This way, you and your household can:
 - a. Participate in the litany on Sunday morning as you watch online worship
 - b. Or... if you are attending in-person worship that day, you can re-create that litany with your household at some other time that weekend.

Note: *The important thing is that you purchase your advent candles and/or wreath now (due to possible back-orders). We (the church) are only offering these links (on page 3) as suggestions for the kinds of things to have ready by 11/29/20 (the first Sunday of Advent), and if you already have your own advent candles and/or wreath, feel free to use them.*

Another note: *if you have difficulty ordering things online, feel free to call Kathleen in the church office and she can assist you...*

COVID Update

Given the time of my time away from Decatur last week and the announcement of this news from our state officials, we could not get this announcement in last week's Visitor; therefore, we share it here. This is the same announcement as was emailed and posted at the end of last week.

As you are probably aware by now, Macon County has been put under Resurgence Mitigations due to the COVID-19 pandemic as of November 1, 2020. After consultation and conversation with the Macon County Health Department, we learned that the 25-person limit on social gatherings does, in fact, pertain to houses of worship in general and worship services in particular. As we have publicly shared with you – the church family – from the beginning of this pandemic, our church leadership committed to erring on the side of caution and following the guidelines handed down by our local, regional and state authorities. Therefore we plan to remain consistent with this practice and abide by the latest round of directives.

What does that mean for us, beginning this Sunday, November 8 (until further notice)?

- Fortunately, due to our already-in-place precautions, not much. We still plan on having in-person worship (with all of the usual guidelines in place – temperature checks, masks, hand-washing, social distancing).
- We will continue to offer an outstanding online option as well (with all services live-streamed). Given that, if you are in any way hesitant about in-person worship, this would be an ideal time to remain at home on Sundays and support Central through virtual attendance.
- For the in-person worship community, we are looking at adding additional safety measures that ensure that we abide by the 25-person gathering limit.

Your pastoral staff, congregation president, and congregation vice-president understand that this latest news likely adds to the overall sense of fatigue many of us feel regarding the current pandemic, but we are committed to keeping our congregation together through these difficult times, and trust in your understanding and willingness to be flexible to allow that to remain a most realistic possibility.

If anyone wishes to speak more about this – with either myself or the congregational president (Gregg Foltz) or vice-president (Brett Swallow) – please don't hesitate to let me know. I will be happy to direct you accordingly. Thank you for your continued commitment to, and support of, Central!
