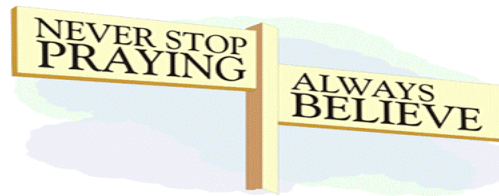

What was a favorite role you filled on a team?

“All Good Things - Teamwork!”

Nehemiah was a man, chosen by God to lead a team of willing people in doing the work of God.

Nehemiah 1:3

They said to me, “Those who survived the exile and are back in the province are in great trouble and disgrace. The wall of Jerusalem is broken down, and its gates have been burned with fire.”

Nehemiah 2:8

“And the King granted me what I asked, for the good hand of my God was upon me.”

Nehemiah 2:17-18

... “You see the trouble we are in: Jerusalem lies in ruins, and its gates have been burned with fire. Come, let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem, and we will no longer be in disgrace.” I also told them about the gracious hand of my God on me and what the king had said to me.” They replied, “Let us start rebuilding.” So, they began this good work. There are forty-two distinct groups of workers listed in the chapter 3 of Nehemiah.

Nehemiah 6:15

So, the wall was completed on the twenty-fifth of Elul, in fifty-two days.

1. Nehemiah prepared.
2. Nehemiah assembled people into a team.



1 Corinthians 12: 12-13

For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. 13 For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body.

1 Corinthians 12: 4-7

Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.
