This is not to be confused with the capital campaign, which occurs every three years. What we pledge now for 2022 will support the day to day operations of the church. Contributions fund ministries such as Christian Education, youth programs, our choir, and local not for profit organizations such as DOVE, the Oasis Day Center, and the Good Samaritan Inn. We also pay the salaries of our ministers and staff along with recurring bills such as insurance and utilities.

The theme of our campaign is ALL GOOD GIFTS. God blesses all of us, and everything we have is a gift from God. Many of you are faithful givers. What motivates you to share what you have with the church? Maybe it's our talented ministers and directors who each week offer thought provoking sermons, imaginative children's moments, or beautiful music. Or knowing your gifts are shared with various organizations who help provide the least of us with food and shelter.

In Sympathy We Mourn



Narcan Training #2

We will host another Narcan training on Tuesday, October 19th, at 7:00 PM. Narcan is a life-saving medication that can be administered to a person experiencing an opioid overdose. Mike Burkham of Decatur Ambulance and the Macon County Health Department will be here to answer your questions about the opioid epidemic in Decatur and the nation and to train participants on how to administer Narcan. Narcan can be dispensed as an inhalant, and each person who attends the class will be given emergency doses of Narcan to keep with them in case they encounter someone having an overdose. This is yet another way we can "serve our neighbors". We hope you will take advantage of this class.
