Minister's Article

"A Word of Glory"

This Sunday is our annual Consecration Sunday - the time of year we consider how we can support the church's ministries in the coming year with our own personal offerings. Specifically, we ask one another to consider turning in an Estimate of Giving card which allows us to prepare a church budget for 2022. During worship on Consecration Day, we ask God to bless and make holy the Estimate of Giving cards we have received. For this reason, it is quite appropriate that the choir will be singing, for the anthem at the 10:30 service, a setting of the Old Hundredth Psalm Tune.

The Old Hundredth is based— not surprisingly — on Psalm 100. In the 1560s, it was set to a melody that is still quite familiar to us (in fact, that melody can be found in our Chalice Hymnal as #18 - "All People that on Earth do Dwell"). The particular setting of the Old Hundredth the choir will offer this Sunday was composed for the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II in 1953! We, the congregation, will even have the chance to sing along with the choir during the anthem.



The Old Hundredth is a "doxology" of sorts. The word "doxology" comes from two Greek words, meaning "word" and "glory." Thus a doxology is a "word of glory" (a word of praise and thanksgiving) offered to God. The words of Psalm 100 (and sung in the Old Hundredth) reveal **why** it is that we should give glory to God; **why** we should offer praise and thanksgiving to God. According to the anthem, all people on earth are to "sing," "praise," "rejoice" and "serve," because God made us, feeds us and shepherds us. And because God's goodness and mercy will endure forever.

I find it quite fitting that the Old Hundredth will play a role in our Consecration Day service this year. For even though things like the filling-in Estimate of Giving cards, preparing budgets and making future plans can seem more mechanical than spiritual, even these base and rudimentary practices are ways of acknowledging that God made us, God feeds us, God shepherds us and that we trust and believe God's goodness and mercy to endure forever. We may not always think of the offerings we give as "doxologies," or expressions of praise and thanksgiving. But they really are — and the Old Hundredth helps us see them in this light.

Room Number Changes after Elevator Renovation

During elevator renovation, the floors and corresponding buttons within the elevator were changed. In order to reduce confusion between the elevator labeling and the rooms, we have relabeled our rooms to match the elevator floors. 1R &
