The Meaning of "Thank You"

In Sickness and in Health The sick were removed outside the "city limits" Segregated away from the healthy Had to shout "Unclean! Unclean!"

Jesus heals 10 Lepers 9 do as they're told 1 returns and "thanks" Jesus (praised by Jesus)

Thank you (Greek) = Eucharisto ("Eucharist")

Eu – good Charis – gift (grace) Thank you is something we say when we recognize a good gift from God Thank you is more than a positive attitude Thank you is recognizing God's grace has touched our life

v. 19 – "Your faith as made you well"

Jesus says this to the one who said "thank you" For Jesus:

Thankfulness = Faithfulness Faithfulness = Thankfulness

Challenge for the rest of the month:

As you look back over 2021, if you had to "turn back" to Jesus and say thank you for some grace you received, what would it be?



Luke 17:11-19 NRSV

¹¹On the way to Jerusalem Jesus was going through the region between Samaria and Galilee. ¹²As he entered a village, ten lepers approached him. Keeping their distance, ¹³they called out, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" ¹⁴When he saw them, he said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were made clean. ¹⁵Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice. ¹⁶He prostrated himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him.
