Steiner-Hochwartner Duo Trombone and Organ Concert

November 10th, 2019, at 4:00 PM

Italian Trombonist Peter Steiner's playing has been described as "beautifully controlled with a vocal sound" and he is recognized around the world as "a new trombone star with-in his generation". His 2018-2019 season involves extensive international travel and features over 100 performances, including a 3-month World Tour of the United States, Europe, Asia, and South America with Constanze Hochwartner as Duo Steiner-Hochwartner, as well as solo concerts with orchestras around the globe. Constanze Hochwartner has given solo performances around the globe, including organ concerts in Europe, the United States, and South America. In 2017, Constanze began collaborating with trombonist Peter Steiner and formed the Duo Steiner-Hochwartner. Constanze's debut album SAPPHERE, in collaboration with Peter Steiner, was released in July 2019 under the Berlin Classics label. Their CD Release Tour brought them to Europe, Asia, Australia, and the United States.
