
Food Collection

A God of Abundance

It has been a busy time of year this past month at Central and the coming weeks will present just as much activity. With each event that stands out on the calendar, we are taken through a myriad of positive and heart-wrenching emotions.



This past **Sunday (3/24)** we enjoyed the baptism of David King! David and his wife Nancy have been attending the 8:00 a.m. service regularly since Christmas and attended Welcome 101 in January. David is the son of Bess and (the late) Harold King. Though we don't normally have baptisms outside of worship, this baptism was more conducive to David's personal and family plans. Ten family members and five elders from Central were there to witness the baptism.

About 3 hours before that baptism took place, Jamie Lesko Reed joined the church at the 9:00 a.m. service. Jamie's son Emmitt graduated from our preschool a year ago and her mother, Cindy Grabowski, has been a stalwart volunteer ever since she joined in October, 2017. Jamie cites the family atmosphere as a big reason why she is moved to call Central home. Moreover, Jamie is the 9th new member in the last 8 weeks!





Even as the baptism of David King was finishing upon in the sanctuary, a luncheon in the Great Hall for **David and Katie Miller** was concluding. David and Kaite have been members of Central for nearly 30 years. David has sung in the choir for 25 of those 30 and Katie for the last 10. In order to be closer to grandchildren, they are moving north. In recent years alone, Katie has

been a vital part of our elder team, organizing our outreach communion, as well as heading up our shepherding department. Both David and Katie will be greatly missed.

In two weeks from today, our sanctuary will be filled with church members, students, faculty and alumna/e from Millikin University to eulogize Ed Acheson on the occasion of his passing. Ed was a beloved member of our Central family and the Decatur community who passed away on March 14. And on Sunday, between services, we learned that our beloved former custodian Dave Flanders passed away.
