

Prayer of Dedication

This past Sunday, we dedicated the new artwork in the Friendship Center, titled "Acceptance." We had a wonderful service in the Friendship Center underneath the artwork itself. I was charged with drafting the actual prayer of dedication at the end of the service. I wanted to share it with you here. Don chose "This is My Father's World" as a theme hymn for the day and I wanted the prayer to reflect the essence of the hymn.

This is my Father's world, and to my listening ears, all nature sings and round me rings the music of the spheres. This is my Father's world; I rest me in the thought of rocks and trees, of skies and seas; God's hands the wonders wrought. (verse 1)



Let us pray...

O God, your gifts abound all around us; evident in a creation that is forever revealing its signs of life. The clouds that float in the sky above us; the water that swirls around us; the fruit of the vine that hovers over us; grains of the field that expand out before us; the sun that rises on day and sets on evening to the sides of us. This is Our Father's world and we are blessed to be part of it.

O God, your gifts of salvation abound all around us; evident in the richest symbols of our faith, revealing signs of eternal life. The body of Christ, gathered from grains collected and kneaded into loaves broken in a meal of remembrance. The blood of Christ, crushed from grapes harvested from vineyards revealing their contents contained in a chalice lifted for all from behind a table made of simple wood and fashioned together by the touch of a carpenters' hand. The waters of immersion welcoming us into a community of the saved, sealed by the promises carried by a dove descending from heaven and marking us as holy. This is Our Father's spiritual world and we are blessed to be part of it.

O God, you are a god of Acceptance. You truly welcome us all, no barriers preventing our advent to you. You come to all, no obstacles inhibiting your advent to us. This is your building – a servant minister in its own right. We are simply those who are called to open the door of acceptance to all who come seeking your gifts of life.

We now dedicate and commend this Friendship Center artwork, entitled "Acceptance," to be a sign and symbol of your endless hospitality and your boundless generosity. May all whose eyes gaze upon it find, in these symbols, glimpses of you, reflections of our very selves, and the grace and faith which forever connect us. And should our eyesight waver, and we become unable to distinguish the details of this artwork one from another, may our eyes of faith perceive what our bodily eye cannot. The deep and abiding truth you convey, which we pray is experienced by all who enter this church. Acceptance: all are welcome here. In your holy name we pray. Amen.
