Minister's Article

Capital Campaign 2019-2022

As you know, Central is beginning another three-year capital campaign this month. The theme is *Preserving our Past, Preparing our Future*. We believe Central is unique among Disciples churches across the country in two ways: 1) We have voluntarily embraced triennial (3-year) capital campaigns for several decades, which has allowed us to improve our building and property gradually over time; subsequently, our building and grounds are in great shape and have been able to evolve to meet the needs of changing generations (the major 2016 renovations are the latest example of such evolution), and 2) we voluntarily dedicate 10% of our goals to outreach in the Decatur area. This means that every three years, we routinely make gifts of fifty thousand dollars (more or less)!

Our 2019-2022 campaign, with the theme *Preserving the Past, Preparing the Future,* has a goal of \$550,000. This is the same goal as the 2016-2019 campaign, which means that if we all continue to give at our previously committed rate, we should easily meet the goal. The funds raised will be spent in three (3) ways: First (1), because the congregation voted to borrow funds to renovate the West Entrance and Friendship Center three years ago, more than half the receipts are dedicated to reducing that obligation. Second (2), 25% of the funds will be used to improve the West Entrance elevator, Great Hall, Heritage Center, and Ramp Entrance areas. Finally (3), 10% of all monies are designated for Decatur area outreach. Here are the dates of some events during the month of June to help celebrate our campaign:
