Minister's Article

Capital Campaign 2019-2022

Over the last week, we mailed out some specific information about our current capital campaign: *Preserving our Past, Preparing our Future.* In addition, we included a commitment card. Those cards represent our estimates for what we hope to contribute to the campaign over the next three years. They can be mailed back to the church anytime this week, or they can be brought to the church this Sunday (June 23). During services this weekend, they will be collected (along with our regular offerings) and then blessed with a special prayer of dedication. Of course, for those needing more time, the cards can be submitted anytime after June 23 as well.

To celebrate the campaign and the great things it will allow us to accomplish, we will be serving "Sundaes on Sunday" on June 23! After each service, there will be an ice cream bar which will offer ice cream with a variety of assorted topping choices. Additionally, after the 10:30 service, we will be sharing the grand total represented by all of our commitment cards. As of the time of this writing, we have already received commitments representing \$214,630, which means that we are almost half-way to our goal of \$550,000.

One of the families that is such a big part of our present, and whose participation inspires us as we look to the future, shared some words with me in support of our church and the campaign. I wanted to share them with you here:

We live in Mt. Zion and have attended Central Christian Church with our two sons, Drake (senior in High School) and Kellan (grade 1) for the past five years. Generally, we choose between the 9:00 am service and the 10:30 am service - whichever best fits our busy schedule. Drake was baptized in 2014 and has attended youth group and youth mission trips, and Kellan is a regular in Sunday School and Vacation Bible School. We first met the Karunas family at a common friend's cookout about five years ago. Pastor Michael and family left us with such a feeling of compassion and sincerity that we decided to check out Central Christian. Once we visited, the Sunday messages delivered, as well as the friendly atmosphere, have made Central Christian our church home.

We have supported the Capital Campaigns since attending Central Christian for a variety of reasons. The new entrance and Welcome Center always give us an inviting feeling when we arrive at Church. With such great renovations already being completed, it proves Central Christian is looking to the future while improving a great existing foundation for generations to come. Our family will continue to support the new Capital Campaign, as it is our desire to continue to improve our building for not only its current members but for the future members of Central Christian Church. Maintaining the historical features of the Church while adding new technology and a modern feel testifies to the commitment our Church has to Decatur and the congregation Central Christian serves. We challenge our church to support such a vital campaign to maintain a rock-solid foundation for the continued growth and diversity of Central Christian Church.
