

Feedback Encouraged

As we slowly turn the page from summer to fall, we welcome your feedback in two (2) important areas of the church's ministry. The first regards the 2019-2022 capital campaign that we just concluded at the end of June. As part of our ongoing 3-year capital campaigns, we dedicate 10% of all funds received to help community organizations. From our 2019-2022 capital campaign, we currently have the 10% ready to give to the Decatur and/or central Illinois community.

A group is being established for the purpose of making decisions about the disbursement of these funds — has already collected some ideas about where these funds could go, but it does not want to exclude your own. Traditionally, these funds have been distributed among local (Decatur-area) and/or regional (Central Illinois) entities, not necessarily affiliated with the Disciples of Christ, though a Disciples connection is always welcome. *If you have an agency in mind you would like to see some of our finances support, please let us know.* We cannot promise all suggestions will be supported. But rest assured the task force will honor and consider all suggestions. We would like your suggestions by: Sunday, August 28. Feel free to send them to central@cccdisciples.org.
